### Payment Option Form Instructions

The Payment Option Form provides you the option of receiving payment through wire transfer or check. Please only complete the information for one of these two options. If both options are selected, the Trust will proceed with issuing a wire payment.

#### *How to find required information for wire payments:*

##### ABA Routing Number

If you select to be paid via wire and live within the United States, you will need to provide an ABA Routing Number. This is **not** the same as the routing number on the bottom of a check (as seen in the image below). The ABA Routing Number is often referred to as an ABA Code or Fedwire. This is a nine (9) digit bank code utilized to identify financial institutions and is often displayed on a customer's bank statement. If you need further assistance locating your ABA Routing Number, please contact your bank directly.

If you select to be paid via Wire and live outside of the United States, you will need to provide a SWIFT Code. A SWIFT code also known as a Bank Identifier Code (BIC), is the unique identifier for a particular bank. A SWIFT Code is comprised of eight (8) or eleven (11) letters and/or numbers. If you need further assistance locating your SWIFT Code, please contact your bank directly.

##### Bank Account Number

Your Bank Account Number can be found within documents such as your bank statement or your checks, as illustrated in green in the image below. If you need further assistance locating your Bank Account Number, please contact your bank directly.
